WEIGHTS AND MEASURES ACT, 1904.

NOTICE OF EXAMINATION OF PATTERN No. 223.



The Board of Trade have examined and tested, with reference to the material of which and the principle on which it is constructed, a pattern of liquid-measuring and delivering apparatus, embodying a rotary piston pump and two 1 gallon calibrated containers, and utilising the air displaced by the filling of one container for the purpose of accelerating the discharge from the other, of the form shown herein, submitted to the Department under the provisions of Section 6 of the above Act, and have issued a certificate (No. 179), dated 15th September, 1923, that the pattern is not such as to facilitate the perpetration of fraud when used for the supply of petrol and other liquids of low viscosity.
