

WEIGHTS AND MEASURES ACT. 1904

NOTICE OF EXAMINATION OF PATTERN No. 307.



The Board of Trade have examined and tested with reference to the material of which and the principle on which it is constructed, a pattern of a liquid measuring and delivering apparatus consisting of a subdivided 5 gallon container filled by means of a pump; up to a fixed overflow, of the form shown herein, submitted to the Department under the provisions of Section 6 of the above Act. The discharge from the container is controlled by a counterweighted hand operated valve, the intermediate quantities being determined by the operator observing the surface of the liquid and the graduations on the container. The full capacity of the measure' is determined by means of a weir on the discharge pipe. As the result of the examination was not satisfactory the Board have declined to issue a certificate.
